



Dr. Hiroshi Morita was born in 1960, and graduated from Tokyo University of Pharmacy & Life Sciences, where he completed his Ph.D. degree under the supervision of Prof. Hideji Itokawa in 1988. In 1988 he joined Bristol-Myers Company, Division of Natural Products Chemistry where he worked on research for bioactive substances from microorganisms. He became a faculty member of Tokyo University of Pharmacy & Life Sciences in 1989. In 1997 he received the JSP Award for Young Scientists about research of bioactive cyclic peptides from higher plants. In 1998 he moved to Hokkaido University as an Associate Professor and appointed as a full professor at Hoshi University in 2005. In 2008 he received the JSP Award for Scientific Contributions about research of polycyclic alkaloids from higher plants. Now He is a chairperson of department of drug discovery science course in Hoshi univeristy and also an associate editor of Journal of Natural Medicines. His research interests are research for bioactive ingredients from plant materials.
